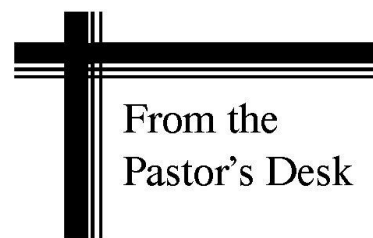
Bereavement Ministry

We had a terrific start to our school year last week. This week our three year old Nursery Program begins. The full and half day programs begin slowly with shortened sessions and parents in attendance on Monday and Tuesday. On those days, students will be in from 10:00-11:00. On Wednesday, our full day program will be in session from 8:00-12:55. On Thursday and Friday, full day students will be in from 8:00-2:50 and half day students will be in from 8:00-10:50.

Meet the Teacher Night takes place on Tuesday evening in the gym. This is a great opportunity to get acquainted with your child's teacher. The teachers will discuss their curriculum and expectations for the coming year. I look forward to seeing all of our parents at this all important meeting aimed at opening the lines of communication. At 9:00 pm there will be a High School Information Meeting for the parents of our seventh and eighth grade students. Tons of information will be given out so it is important that each 8th grade student is represented. This meeting will take place in the gym after visiting the classrooms.

VIRTUS CLASSES will be given by Laura Ciraolo from the Faith Formation Program at Sacred Heart School. The first one will be at SHS on Thursday evening, September 12th. The second one, also given at SHS, will be on Monday evening, September 30th. Anyone who works with children in the Brooklyn Diocese (lunch parents, fundraising, sports, chaperone, etc.) must have Virtus Training. This class will discuss appropriate and inappropriate conduct in dealing with children. It also helps raise awareness regarding possible sexual predators. You only need to attend one class.
