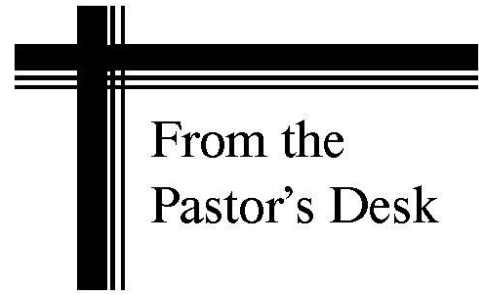
ENVELOPES REGARDING ALL SAINTS DAY

School is closed tomorrow as we celebrate Columbus Day. Classes will resume on Tuesday.

Tuesday begins Terra Nova Testing in grades 3-8. These tests are a measure of what skills students have mastered and what skills need more focus. In order to assess student ability, there will be a variety of questions in the area of Reading, Math and Language. This year there are some changes to our traditional Terra Nova Tests. These tests will be based on the new Common Core Curriculum and will mimic the format of the New York State exams, however, this is a test that is administered across the nation and compares a larger population of students in each grade. It is important for students to be present each day the test is given. The students will take a section of the test each day. The test will be completed next Monday. Students should get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast before coming to school each day. Several #2 pencils with clean erasers are required.

There is a Dress Down on Thursday for students in grades K-8.
