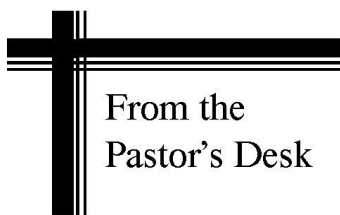

Bereavement Ministry

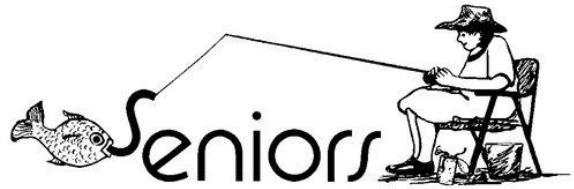
