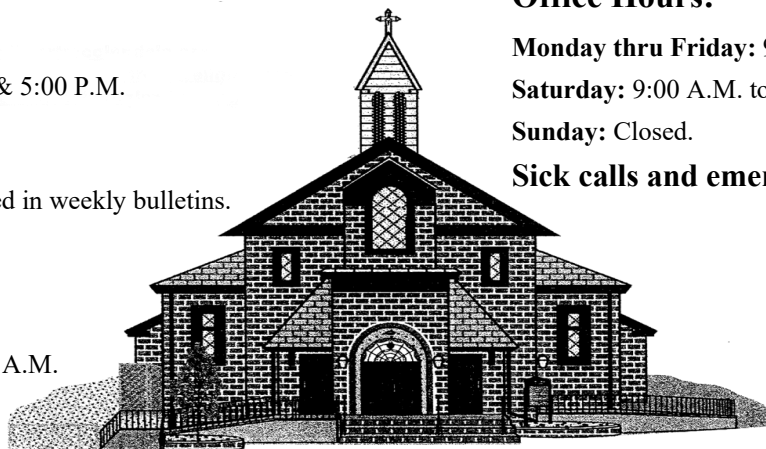

ABSTINENCE from meat to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and on all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 year of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, according to one's needs. No eating between meals, only water is permitted.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held every Friday during Lent at 7:30pm with the exception of First Fridays March 3rd and April 7th.

DURING LENT NO FLOWERS ARE TO BE BROUGHT INTO CHURCH OR LEFT AT ANY OF THE HOLY SHRINES.

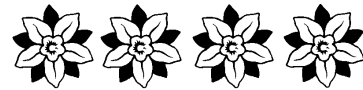
