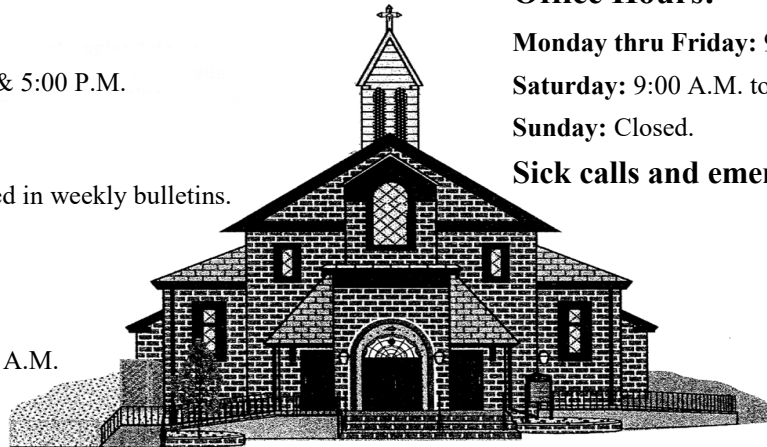

**Please Note:** On the Eve and on Palm Sunday, palms will be blessed at each Mass. As you enter the Church, the usher will hand you a piece of palm. We ask that you hold it in your hand as the priest blesses it. The Blessing will take place at the beginning of each Mass.

**ABSTINENCE** from meat to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and on all Fridays of Lent.

**FASTING** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, according to one's needs. No eating between meals, only water is permitted.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** will be held every Friday during Lent at 7:30pm with the exception of First Fridays March 3rd and April 7th.
