

Have you noticed that currently most gospels are taken from Matthew? Yet, there are times most gospels are taken from Mark or Luke. This is because in 1969 the Catholic Church adapted a 3 year cycle of readings for Sundays. The Church is currently in cycle A and most gospels are from Matthew. Advent begins a new liturgical year and cycle B will begin. You will notice that most of the gospels will reflect the writings of Mark. As the Church transitions to Cycle C the following Advent, the gospels will be taken from Luke. The Gospel of John is scattered in all three cycles because of its unique themes.

This change was made in 1969 so that Catholics would become more familiar with the text of the Bible.




FOOD PANTRY
