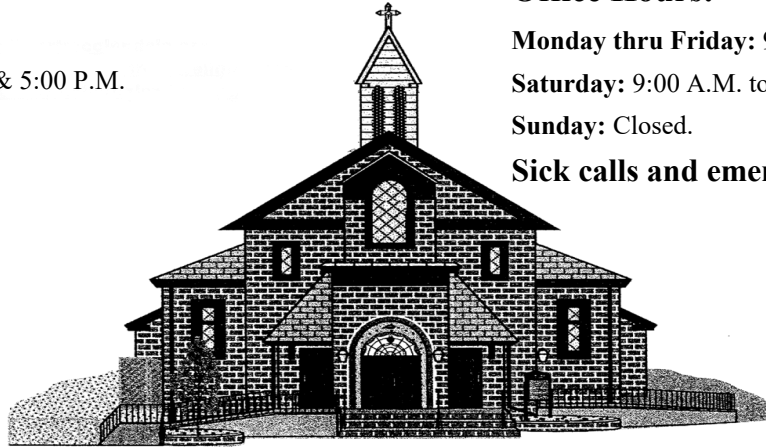

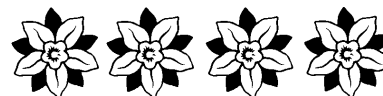

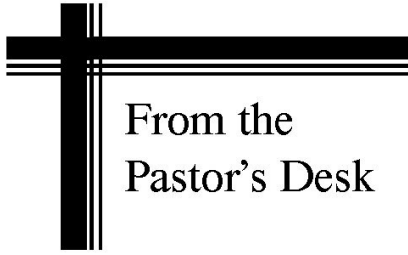

We had a terrific start to our school year last week. This week our three year old Nursery Program begins. In addition to our four days a week half day program, we also have a full day, 5 days a week program. The Nursery Programs begin slowly with shortened sessions on Monday and Tuesday (parents in attendance on Monday). On those days' students will be in from 10:00-11:00. On Wednesday, our full day program will be in session from 8:10-12:55. On Thursday and Friday, full day students will be in from 8:10-2:45 and half day students will be in from 8:10-10:50.

Meet the Teacher Night takes place on Thursday evening at 7:30 in the gym. This is a great opportunity to get acquainted with your child's teacher. The teachers will discuss their curriculum and expectations for the coming year. I look forward to seeing all of our parents at this all important meeting aimed at opening the lines of communication. At 9:00 there will be a High School Informational Meeting for the parents of our seventh and eighth grade students. Tons of information will be given out so it is important that each 8th grade student is represented. This meeting will take place in the gym after visiting the classrooms.

Paul Efmann Music Services will give their band demonstration on Wednesday, September 13th at 12:00 in the gym. The presentation introduces band instruments taught by the music service on Tuesday afternoons in our school. Students have an opportunity to sign up for this optional program that enhances students learning. Parents are invited to attend.

Also this week we begin our Prestige Sale and special subject classes. Pretzels on Wednesday and ice cream on Friday will begin the following week. Please supply your child with a snack and drink on Wednesday.

**VIRTUS CLASSES** will be given by Laura Ciralo from the Faith Formation Program at Sacred Heart Catholic Academy on Thursday evening, September 21st from 7:00 pm to 10:00pm. Anyone who works with children in the Brooklyn Diocese (lunch parent, fundraising, sports, chaperone, scouts, etc.) must have Virtus Training.
