





I hope you had the chance to enjoy the summer months as they quickly flew by. Now it's time to look forward to a new school year. School opens once again on Wednesday, September 6th and I'm very excited about meeting the children after their summer vacation. It is always amazing to see how much they have grown during the last two months.

The first week of school will be half days as both students and teachers ease into their new schedules. Grades 1-8 will arrive at 8:00 and dismiss at noon on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. New students in Grades 1-8, report to the school office. Kindergarten will begin on Wednesday and their three day schedule will be from 9:00-11:30. Pre-K begins on Wednesday as well from 10:00 until 11:30 and 8:00-11:15 on Thursday and Friday (parents in attendance on Wednesday only). Nursery begins next week on Monday, September 11th.

On Friday grades 1-8 will attend the 8:30 Mass to celebrate the new school year. September birthdays will be acknowledged following the Mass. I hope that everyone will join us in this celebration.

Following the Mass, at approximately 9:30, there will be an important meeting in the school for all parents who have signed up to be lunch supervisors (alternate or on a regular basis; first timers or well seasoned). We all need to be acquainted with the lunch procedures. Our lunch program begins on Monday, September 11th.

Please remember that all important information and notices including the calendar and school policies are posted on the school's website at sacredheartglendale.org. Please be vigilant about checking the site on a regular basis. As usual, there will be some papers coming home with the children the first week of school. We would appreciate it if they could be returned promptly.

Thank you to all those who made our Summer Camp a success once again. Thank you to the teachers who planned, organized and implemented the programs that the children enjoyed. Thank you to the student volunteers from our junior high, from the high schools and also from the colleges. It is wonderful to see them giving back to the Sacred Heart Academy community.
