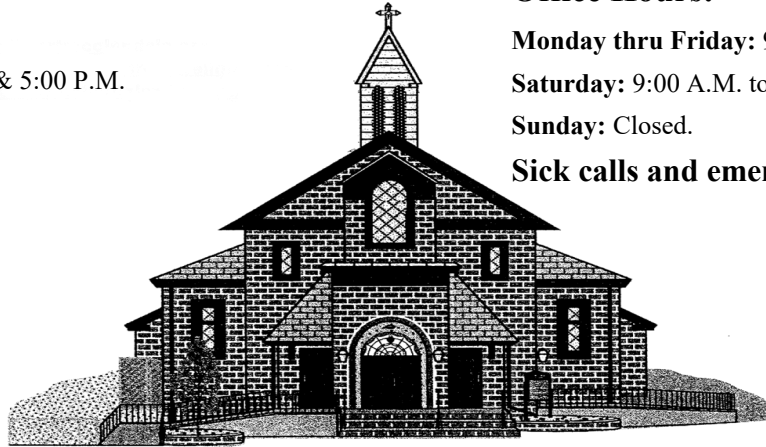

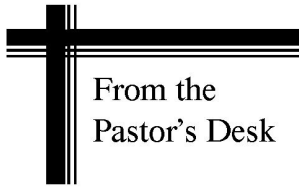

First Friday Mass will be hosted by the second grade. Following the Mass, we will announce our December birthdays and congratulate our Students of the Month for December.

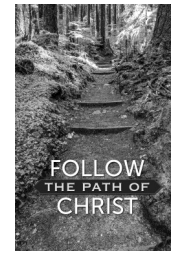
Our Wreath Sale will begin on the weekend of December 2nd outside of the church. Please consider buying a fresh wreath in support of our Academy.
