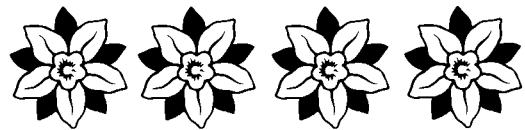


Giving Tree

The Chess Club meets on Tuesday after school.

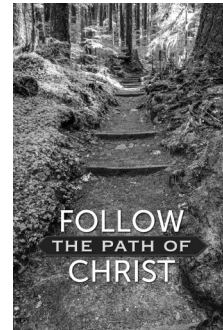
Second grade will receive the Sacrament of First Reconciliation on Wednesday. Please keep these youngsters in your prayers.
