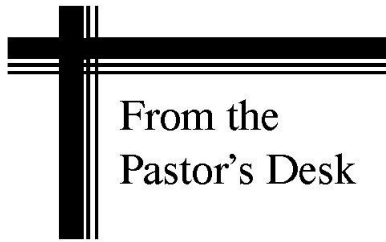

PATHWAY OF PRAYER

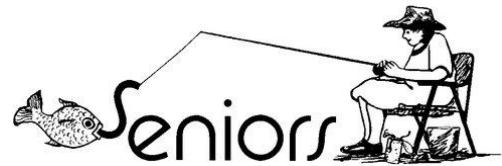
