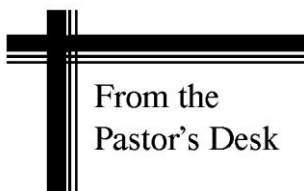

The 20th Annual Msgr. George A. Denzer Memorial Lecture in Sacred Scripture will be held at the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington on Sunday, June 2nd at 3pm. MARRIAGE – The Supreme Court will be deciding by the end of June two cases about whether or not marriage should be redefined to include two persons of the same sex. These cases involve the Federal Defense of Marriage Act (Doma) and California's Proposition 8, both of which define marriage as the union of one man and one woman. A broad negative ruling could redefine marriage in the law throughout the country.
