WHITE ELEPHANT SALE

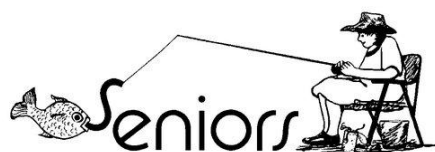

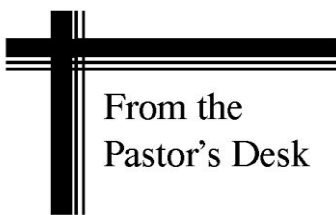
