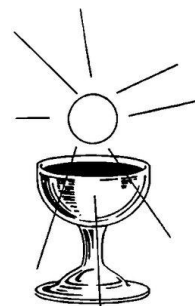

Bereavement Ministry

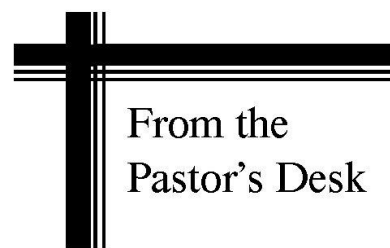
