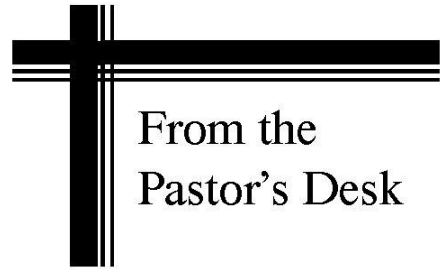


### **WHITE ELEPHANT SALE**
