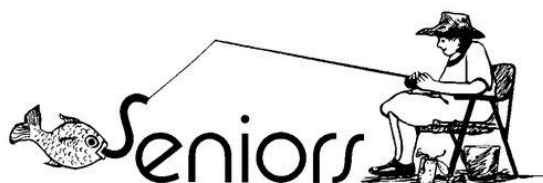

The Sacred Heart Seniors will meet on Thursday, November 14th at 11 AM in the church with a meeting and luncheon to follow in the church basement.

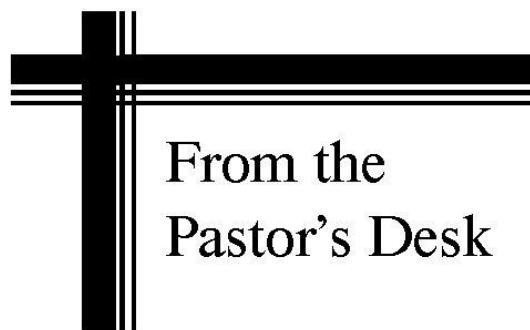
We will be collecting for the following:
