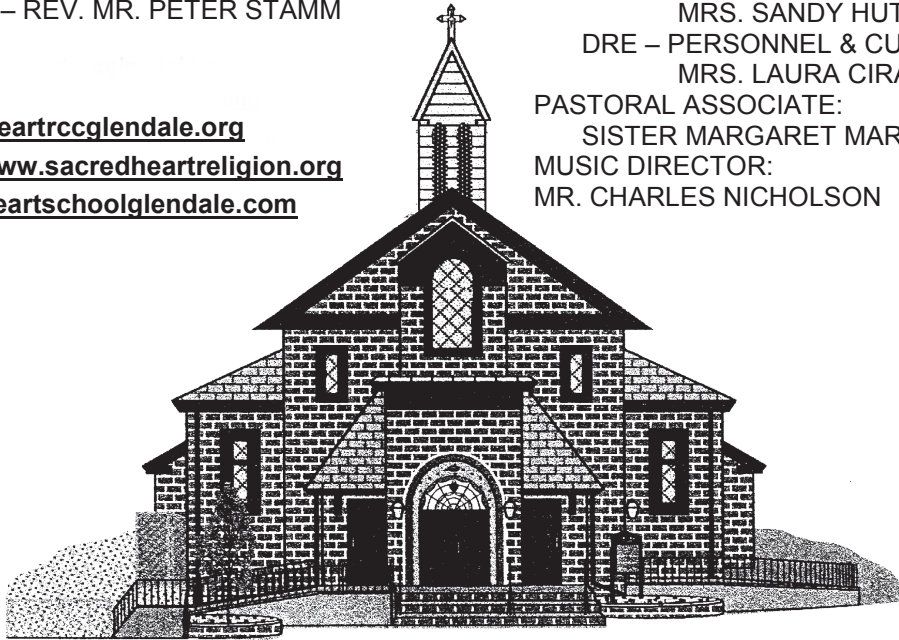

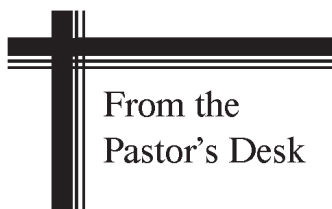

We are beginning two new programs sponsored by the Diocese of Brooklyn's Office of the Superintendent.

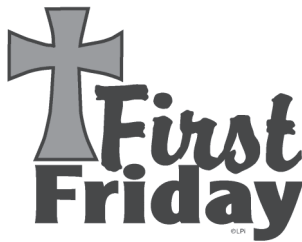

The second program begins this week with our 4th and 5th graders. ASH WEDNESDAY

LENT—ASH WEDNESDAY—MARCH 6

Ashes will be distributed during Mass: 6:30 and 8:30 AM and 7:30 PM. Ashes will be distributed during one Prayer Service at 3:30 PM.

ABSTINENCE from meat to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older, on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if Necessary according to one's needs. Eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

PLEASE TAKE A NAIL TO REMIND US OF CHRIST'S SUFFERING AND ALSO OUR DESIRE TO DO OR NOT TO DO SOMETHING IN LENT TO HELP MAKE THIS SACRIFICE WORTHWHILE. KEEP THIS NAIL UNTIL GOOD FRIDAY WHEN IT WILL BE USED AT THE GOOD FRIDAY LITURGY.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS WILL BE HELD EVERY FRIDAY DURING LENT AT 7:30 PM WITH THE EXCEPTION OF FIRST FRIDAYS.

LENT BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 5. ASHES WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL OUR STUDENTS DURING CLASS TIME. PLEASE MAKE THIS LENTEN SEASON A TIME OF REFLECTION ON YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. MAY GOD BLESS YOU.

DURING LENT NO FLOWERS ARE TO BE BROUGHT INTO CHURCH OR LEFT AT ANY OF THE HOLY SHRINES.

AS PART OF OUR LENTEN PROGRAM, CONFESSIONS WILL BE HEARD AFTER THE 11:30 MASS ON SUNDAYS OF LENT.
