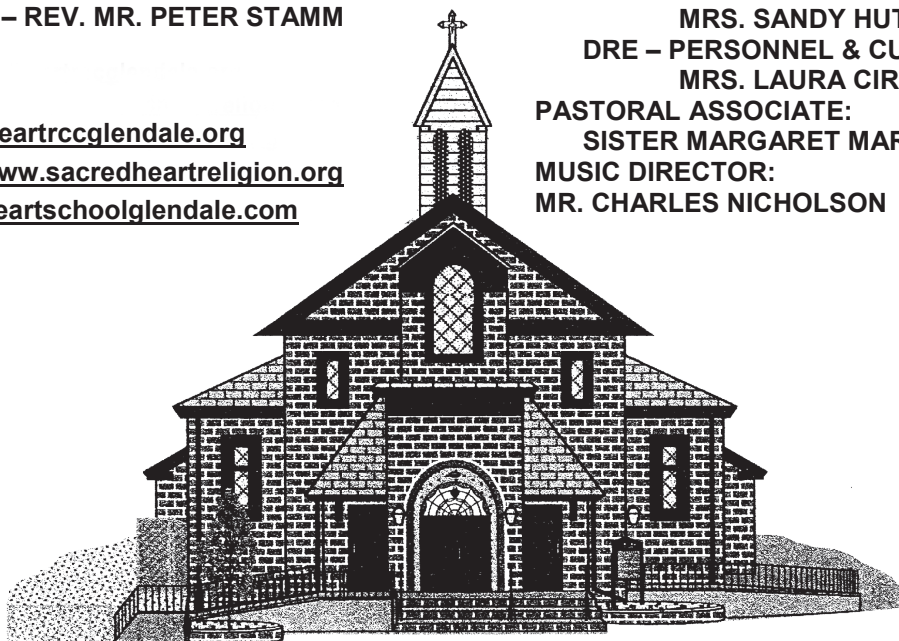

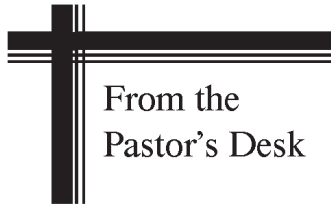

Our April Cake Sale will be held on Tuesday during lunch time.

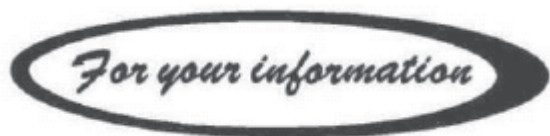
