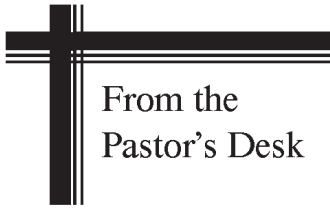

Pre-K and Kindergarten will have their end of year picnic in the meadow on Wednesday.

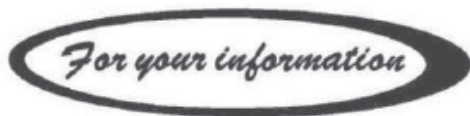
