

Ashes will be distributed during Mass: 6:30 and 8:30 AM and 7:30 PM. Ashes will be distributed during one Prayer Service at 3:30 PM.

ABSTINENCE from meat to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older, on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, according to one's needs. Eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
