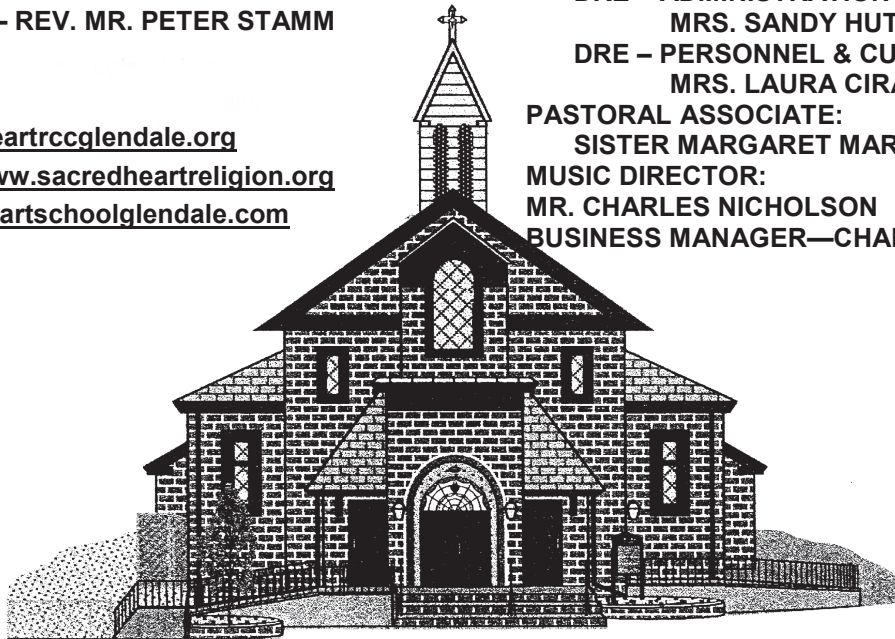

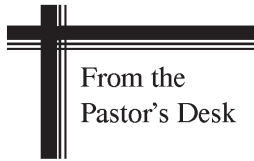

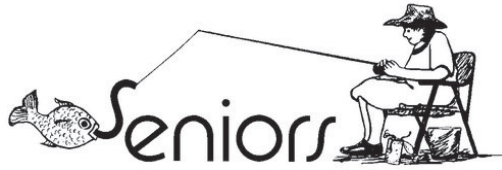
Wednesday, Thursday and Friday the students in grades 4, 6 and 8 will be taking the NYS Math Test.
