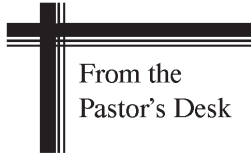

We had a terrific start to our school year last week. This week our three year old Nursery Program begins. In addition to our four days a week half day program, we also have a full day, 5 days a week program. The Nursery Programs begin slowly with shortened sessions on Monday and Tuesday (parents in attendance on Monday). On those days students will be in from 10:00-11:00. On Wednesday, our full day program will be in session from 8:00-12:55. On Thursday and Friday, full day students will be in from 8:10—2:45 and half day students will be in from 8:00-10:50.

Meet the Teacher Night takes place on Tuesday evening at 7:30 in the gym. This is a great opportunity to get acquainted with your child's teacher. The teachers will discuss their curriculum and expectations for the coming year. I look forward to seeing all of our parents at this all important meeting aimed at opening the lines of communication.
