




Sacred Heart will be holding an International Night on Saturday, October 10. For more information you may pick up a flyer in the back of he church.

I hope you had the chance to enjoy the summer months as they quickly flew by. Now it's time to look forward to a new school year. School opens once again on Wednesday, September 9th and I'm very excited about meeting the children after their summer vacation. It is always amazing to see how much they have grown during the last two months.

The first week of school will be half days as both students and teachers ease into their new schedules. Grades 1-8 will arrive at 8am and dismiss at 11:45 on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. New students in Grades 1-8 report to the school office. Kindergarten will begin on Wednesday and their three day schedule will be from 9am-11:30am. Pre-K begins on Thursday from 10am until 11:30am and again on Friday. (parents in attendance on Thursday only). Nursery begins next week on Monday, September 14th.

Doors will open at 8am for regular arrival. It is vitally important that all students arrive on time and enter the building through the stage door. Using the front door is <u>not an option</u> and students will only be allowed to enter after 8:15 when the stage door closes. Students entering after 8:15 will be marked late on the attendance register.

On Friday grades 1-8 will attend the 8:30 Mass to celebrate the new school year. September birthdays will be acknowledged following the Mass. I hope everyone will join us in this celebration.

Following the Mass, at approximately 9:30, there will be an important meeting in the school for all parents who have signed up to be lunch supervisors (alternate or on a regular basis, first timers or well seasoned). We all need to be acquainted with the lunch procedures. Our lunch program begins on Monday, September 14th.

Please remember that all important information and notices including the calendar and school policies are posted on the school's website at sacredheartschoolglendale.com. Please be vigilant about checking the site on a regular basis. As usual there will be some papers coming home with the children the first week of school. We would appreciate it if they could be returned promptly.

This year we welcome two new members to our school faculty. I am sure that you will join me in warmly welcoming Ms. Nicole Panariello who will be teaching Nursery I and Mrs. Nanette Allen who will be the 7th grade homeroom teacher whose responsibilities will include Religion and ELA for grade 7 and Math for grades 6, 7 and 8.
