



# FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK MS. JOANNE GANGI

I hope you had the chance to enjoy the summer months as they quickly flew by. Now it' time to look forward to a new school year. Sacred Heart Catholic Academy opens on Wednesday, September 7th and I'm very excited about this new beginning and meeting the children after their summer vacation. It is always amazing to see how much they have grown in two months.

Remember to join us for our "Ribbon Cutting Celebration at 8:15 outside of school on Wednesday, September 7th. Students should line up on the street under the direction of their teachers (weather permitting). Following the ribbon cutting, all parents and guardians are invited to the gym for morning prayers and refreshments.

DUE TO OUR OPENING CELEBRATION ON SEPTEMBER 7TH, SACRED HEART CATHOLIC ACADEMY HAS PLANNED TO CLOSE 84TH STREET FOR A LIMITED TIME SO THAT STUDENTS AND PARENTS MAY ASSEMBLE ON THE STREET. PLEASE MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO LEGALLY PARK CARS AWAY FROM THE SCHOOL TO AVOID TRAFFIC JAMS AND DANGEROUS SITUATIONS.

The first week of school will be half days as both students and teachers ease into their new schedules. Grades 1-8 will begin at 8:10 and dismiss at noon on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Kindergarten will begin on Wednesday and their three day schedule will be from 9:00-11:30. Pre-K begins on Wednesday from 10:00 until 11:30 and 8:30-11:45 on Thursday and Friday. Nursery begins next week on Monday, September 12th.

Beginning on Thursday, September 8th the doors will open at 8:00 am for regular arrival. It is vitally important that all students arrive on time and enter the building through the stage door. Using the front door is <u>not an option</u> and students will only be allowed to enter after 8:15 when the stage door closes. Students entering after 8:15 will be marked late on the attendance register.

On Friday, grades 1-8 will attend the 8:30 Mass to celebrate the new school year. September birthdays will be acknowledged following the Mass. I hope that everyone will join us in this celebration.

Following the Mass, at approximately 9:30, there will be an important meeting in the school for all parents who have signed up to be lunch supervisors (alternate or on a regular basis; first timers or well seasoned). Our lunch program begins on Monday, September 12th.

Please be vigilant about checking the site on a regular basis. As usual there will be some papers coming home with the children the first week of school. We would appreciate it if they could be completed and returned promptly.

Thank you to the student volunteers from our junior high, from the high schools and also from the colleges. It is wonderful to see them giving back to the Sacred Heart community.
