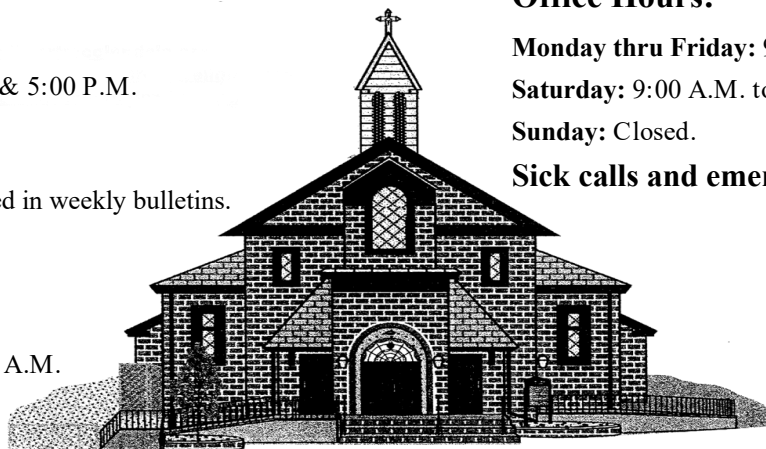

This is a short week for us however there is some important information to convey.

The seventh and eighth grade classes will attend the 9:30 Mass on Sunday. Following the Mass, the eighth graders will proceed to a Proximate Preparation Meeting.

Grades 6, 7 and 8 will take a trip to the Queens County Farm Museum on Monday. The program they will be participating in is called **Colonial Kids: Apple Cider Pressing**. Our students will learn that New York State is the second largest producer of apples in the country and other facts about this significant and popular fruit through discussion about the seasonality of apple orchards and the pollination process. They will be introduced to colonial history and food preservation with apple cider presses, and take part in cider making. Each student will bring home a small bottle of pasteurized cider. This program includes a guided tour of a working farm and historic orchard.

Monday After-School Activities include Drama and Robotics Clubs. Tuesday extra-curricular activities include Chess and Band.

Tuesday is Election Day. School will be open for all students. Our Home/Academy meeting usually held on the second Tuesday of November has been re-scheduled for next Tuesday, November 15th.

School will be closed on Thursday for students in grades N and K-8. Our teachers will be attending a Professional Development Day at Immaculate Conception Center in Douglaston. However, PreK for All will be in session on that day.

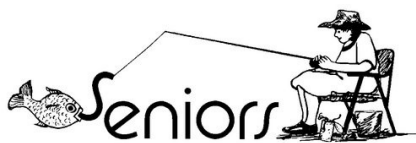
ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL
