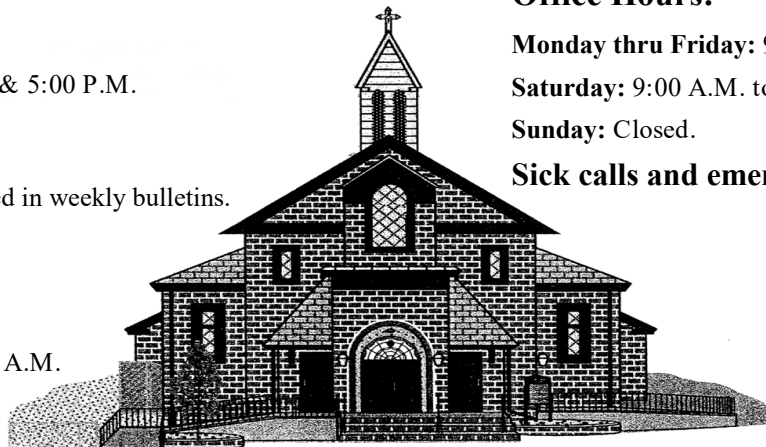

Today, our 7th and 8th grade students will attend the 9:30 mass. Grade 8 will remain after mass for a Proximate Preparation Meeting.

Our 8th graders have been selected to represent private schools across the nation by participating in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP). First administered in 1969, NAEP is the largest nationally representative and continuing assessment of what students in public and private schools know and can do in various subjects. It is administered by the National Center for Education Statistics, within the U.S. Department of Education. NAEP is different from state and school assessments because it provides a common measure of student achievement across the country. The results are released as The Nation's Report Card, which provides information about student achievement to educators, parents, policymakers, and the public.

On Monday, the students will take an assessment in one of the following subjects: civics, geography, mathematics, reading, U.S. history, or writing.

There is a Cake Sale on Tuesday and the Chess Club will meet after school.

The third grade culminates another unit of study in Social Studies. This trimester their focus was on Germany. On Wednesday, they will venture to Manor Oktoberfest and enjoy a German lunch.

Thursday is our monthly Dress Down Day. We have invited a special guest to speak with grades three through eight. Miss New York, Camille Finn will inform our students about her platform which is "Hunger and the Homeless."

We celebrate Teacher Appreciation Day on Friday. The day begins with a breakfast served by our 8th graders.

They've done it again. They have brought home a trophy for the fourth year in a row. FLLASH, our Robotics Club, will be competing at the semi-finals on March 4. On Saturday, February 4th they competed at the Queens Qualifying Event and won 1st Place in Robot Performance. Way to go team!
