

#### The Catholic Altar

Have you ever wondered why some altars in Catholic churches are made from stone while others are made from wood?

In the early years when Christianity was illegal, the Eucharist was typically celebrated in the homes of the faithful. The altar could have been the family table or the wooden chest in which a bishop would carry needed materials for celebrating the Eucharist from place to place.

When Constantine ruled and Christianity was no longer illegal, wood altars and metal altars were used for a time. Preference however, was given to natural stone calling to mind Christ as the living <u>cornerstone</u> of the Catholic faith. At the Second Council of Nicaea in 787, every church was to have a relic at its altar. Popularity for placing an <u>altar stone</u> containing a relic spread during the Renaissance (14c-17c) and thus the altar grew in size resembling a sarcophagus (coffin-like in size).

Catholic altars today are often made of natural stone though an altar made of quality wood is permitted. In 1969 the church no longer required Catholic churches to possess an altar stone containing a relic.

The altar of Sacred Heart Church is made of worthy, solid wood. Respecting early tradition, an altar stone containing a relic in a cavity is embedded in the altar of Sacred Heart Church. This altar stone serves as the essential part of the altar and is covered by altar linens.

Sacred Heart Church is indeed rich in holy tradition!

Kudos to our alumni who achieved Honor Roll status in their high schools for the first trimester.


