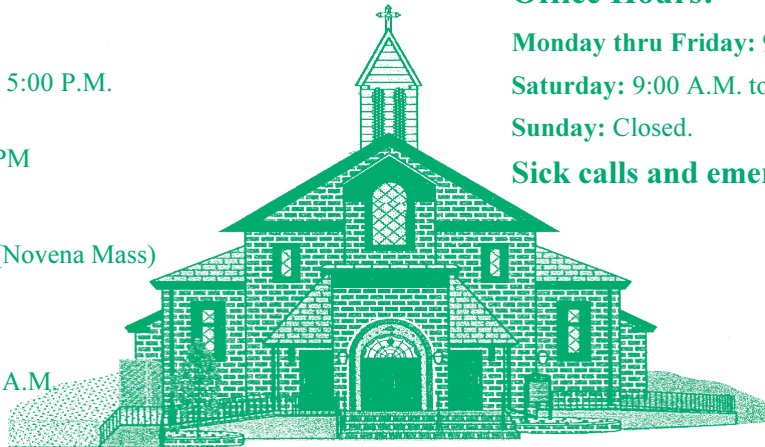

LENT-ASH WEDNESDAY-FEBRUARY 14th

Ashes will be distributed during Mass at 8:30 AM and 7:30 PM. Ashes will be distributed within one Prayer Service at 3:30 PM.

ABSTINENCE from meat to be observed by all Catholics 14 years and older, on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, according to one's needs. No eating between meals, only water is permitted.

PLEASE TAKE A NAIL TO REMIND US OF CHRIST'S SUFFERING AND ALSO OUR DESIRE TO DO OR NOT TO DO SOMETHING IN LENT TO HELP MAKE THIS SACRIFICE WORTHWHILE. KEEP THIS NAIL UNTIL GOOD FRIDAY WHEN IT WILL BE USED AT THE GOOD FRIDAY LITURGY.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS WILL BE HELD EVERY FRIDAY DURING LENT AT 7:30 PM.
