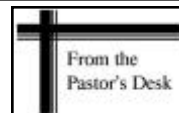
Faith Corner

ADVENT

In the weeks proceeding Christmas, people wear themselves out preparing for Christmas Day. They fill their already full days with shopping, decorating, cooking, baking, etc. for the holiday. Parents hide gifts, answer their children's letter to Santa, fill Christmas stockings, and track Santa's journey on Christmas Eve. This is all fun and part of the joy and expectation of Christmas Day.

However, there was a time when Advent, like Lent, was a period of fasting and penitence. In fact, in the early Church, music and dancing were forbidden during Advent. It was designed to remind us of the need to repent in preparation for the holy season. Advent fasting and almsgiving were practiced to keep people aware of the proper use of material goods.

During this Advent let's borrow tradition from the early Christians and adopt an attitude of joyful fasting and penance. Remember to give to those less fortunate and take time to pray. Prepare your hearts, minds and souls. This is the true season of Advent.

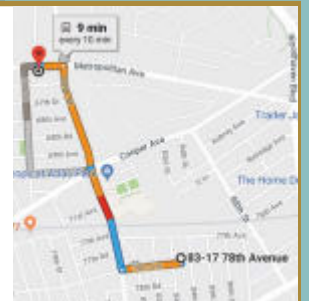
