Faith Corner

Feast of the Immaculate Conception—December 9th December is a month of anticipation as we await the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ, God's gift to us. We also celebrate His Mother, Mary. On December 9th, we commemorate the Blessed Mother's sinless state as we celebrate the Feast of her Immaculate Conception. In 1854, Pope Pius IX's solemn declaration clarified with finality the long-held belief of the Church that Mary was conceived free from original sin. Mary was granted this extraordinary privilege because of Her unique role as the Mother of God.

"O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee." (Miraculous Medal)

Our Lady of Guadalupe Feast Day-December 12th

In 1531 a "Lady from Heaven" appeared to Saint Juan Diego a poor Indian from Tepeyac, a hill northwest of Mexico City. She identified herself as the Mother of the True God and instructed him to have the bishop build a church on the site. As a sign for the bishop, she left an image of herself imprinted miraculously on his tilma, a poor quality cactus-cloth. Her message was one of love and compassion. She promised to help and protect all mankind. An incredible list of miracles, cures and interventions are attributed to Our Lady of Guadalupe. Each year about 10 million people visit her Basilica making it the most popular Marian shrine in the world. Did you know?

- The tilma should have deteriorated within 20 years but shows no sign of decay over 470 years.
- In the eyes of Our Lady of Guadalupe on the tilma, we can see reflected who was in front of her in 1531 (Juan Diego, Bishop Juan de Zummaraga and Juan Gonzales interpreter). This is identical to what is produced in the normal eye but impossible to obtain on a flat surface.
- There is no under sketch, no sizing and no protective coating on the image. No brush strokes are detected.
- The stars on Our Lady's Mantle coincide with the constellation in the sky on December 12, 1531.
- The image seems to increase in size and change colors due to an unknown property of the surface and substance of which it is made.
- The image is smooth and feels like a modern day photograph but it was produced 300 years before the invention of photography.
