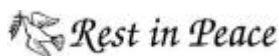

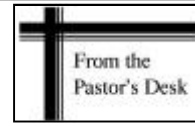

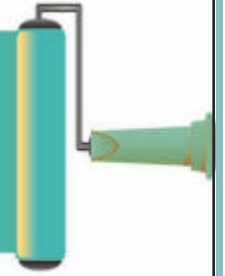
**St. Joseph and St. Pio Prayer Group**
