





The Giving Tree will be setup in the Cronin Room. The entrance is on 84th Street side of the rectory. You can get your STARS two ways.

1. Call the Parish Ministry Office at 718-821-3285 and arrange for a pickup time.

OR

2. Go to the Cronin Mtg. Room after Mass on November 21, 22, 28, 29, December 5, 6, 12, 13. Wearing your mask, you will be given a glove so that you can pick your stars. Social distancing will be observed.

All presents should be wrapped or in gift bags with STAR attached. Gifts can be returned to the Cronin Room on the above dates or call the Parish Ministry Office to arrange your drop off. All gifts must be returned by Friday, December 18th at 3pm. No gifts can be accepted after this date.

- Please come prepared with your requested **Mass** dates and Memorials listed.
- You are encouraged to keep a copy of your request. Please include a check made out to Sacred Heart Church or cash (a receipt will be given later.) Enclose your requests and payment in an envelope.
- Please include the DATE & TIME, FOR WHOM THE MASS IS INTENDED, WHO IS RE-QUESTING THE MASS along with a phone number and email address for questions and/or confirmation and receipt.
- Include your 1st choice and 2nd choice should your 1st choice not be available.
- The cost of Masses remains at \$15.00 each.

School will be closed on Thursday and Friday this week.



- If you do not have access to email, you may call the Parish Ministry office (718)821-3285 with a prayer request or request to be a prayer partner.




The Annual Catholic Appeal is ongoing.
