

Celebration of Marriage



The Church will be closed following the 8:30am Mass. The Rectory Office will be closed.


PRAYER PARTNER PROGRAM

- If you do not have access to email, you may call the Parish Ministry office (718)821-3285 with a prayer request or request to be a prayer partner.




<u>FAREWELL TO CHARLIE NICHOLSON</u>
