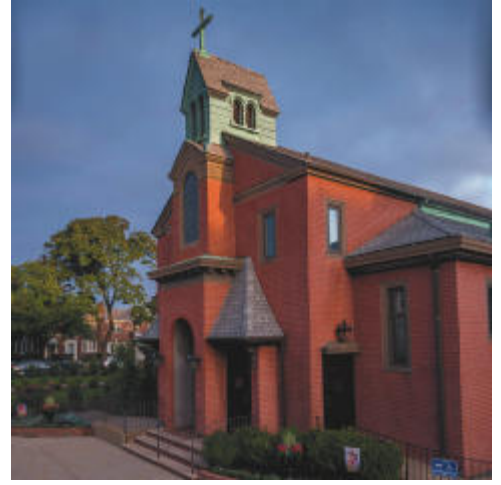

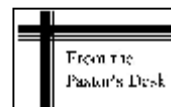
OUR CHRISTMAS ALTAR

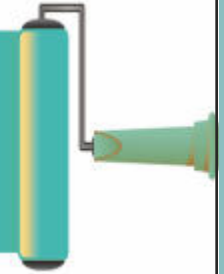

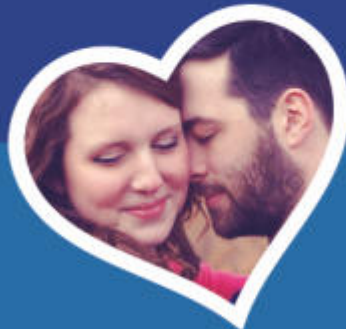

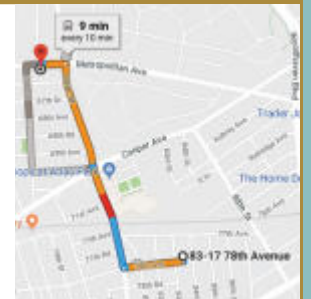
