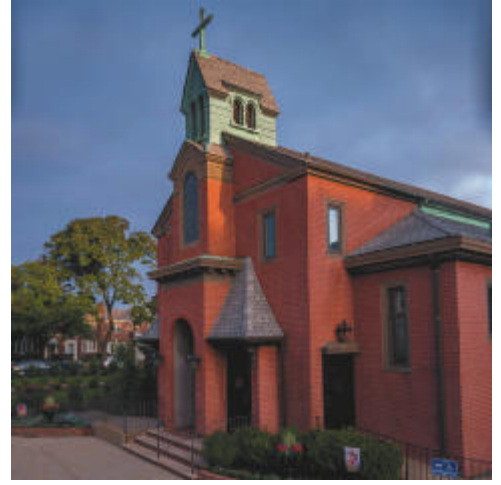

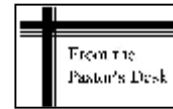

PATHWAY TO PRAYER

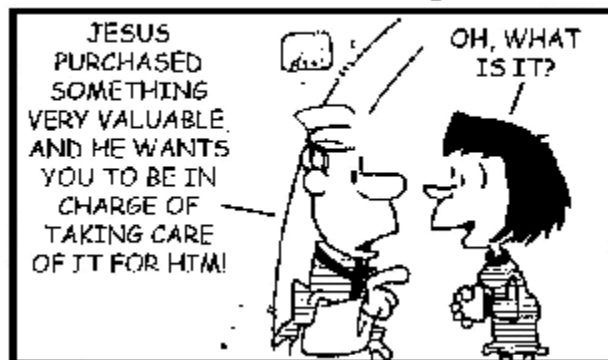
