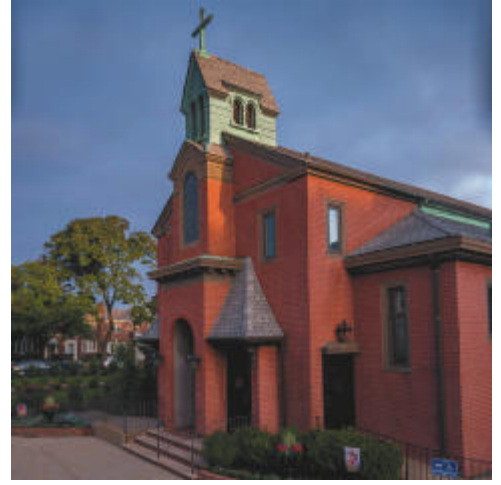

HOLY WATER BLESSING

The next Holy Water Blessing will take place on the weekend of February 6 & 7 at all the Masses.

Holy Water is regular water that has been blessed. It is a sacramental of the Church which means that it has been set aside for a sacred purpose. For us as Catholics, it's main purpose is to remind us of our Baptism. It represents the presence of the Most Holy Trinity within us. Since we have been made holy through holy water it sets us aside from the evils of the world. We use it also as a blessing of our homes, statues, rosaries and other objects that remind us of the presence of God among us.

During the pandemic, we have not been allowed to leave Holy Water in the fonts at the door or in the large font for people to take home. Each First Sunday of the month, we invite you to bring water in your own Holy Water bottles from home. They will be blessed at the end of each Mass. When you use it, please remember to pray for your family and friends and everyone else in our parish who will share in its blessings.

PATHWAY TO PRAYER

All parishioners are invited to consider donating a brick to our "Pathway to Prayer" in front of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Statue, in the Sacred Heart Prayer Garden. A brick can be in memory or honor of your special intentions. Each brick is carved with a personal sentiment.

On December 8, 2020 Pope Francis proclaimed "The Year of St. Joseph" which will last until December 8, 2021. Whenever a Pope announces a special year of prayer it is the hope that each Catholic will renew their devotion to that particular saint or to a particular theological virtue, as we recently celebrated, "The Year of Mercy." In order to enter into "The Year of St. Joseph" as a parish community more fully, beginning next Sunday, January 31st, there will be the opportunity for 35 Parish Households to host the statue of the "Sleeping St. Joseph" for a nine day novena (This new devotion made popular by Pope Francis, reveals Saint Joseph in a sleeping position because in the Scriptures, God always spoke to him in his dreams. Part of this devotion is to place intentions on a small strip of paper and place them under his pillow so that he may present them to the Lord while we are sleeping).

Each household will be given their own small statue of the Sleeping St. Joseph (so there is no passing around one statue from house to house), a reminder of the days that you will be hosting the Novena, a prayer to say each night together and the opportunity to place small strips of paper with special intentions written on it by members of the household to place under the Sleeping St. Joseph's pillow for the duration of the novena and beyond. Each household is asked to pick up from the rectory the statue and prayer card the day before your novena begins.

If you would like to participate in this Parish event, please call the rectory beginning on Monday, January 25th, to reserve your NINE DAY SLOT. Slots will be given on a (first come first served) basis until all 35 novena slots are filled until December 8th.

May God bless you all through the intercession of St. Joseph, Foster Father of Jesus, Husband of Mary, and Patron of the Universal Church, this year and always.



SCHOOL NEWS

Usually this week's Bulletin would be about plans for Catholic Schools Week and all the activities that are taking place including our Open House and Mass. This year, however, **Catholic Schools Week has been moved to the week of February 7th** and will look and feel a little differently.



All Open Houses will be virtual. The faculty is putting the finishing touches on a Power Point that I will present at several Zoom Meetings to be scheduled. Prospective parents will have an opportunity to ask questions at these meetings.

At this time, you may have heard that our PK for All Program is being defunded by the Department of Education. We are appealing this decision, but it is a slow process. In the meantime we will begin planning for our own tuition based PK Program. Prior to contracting with the city, we had a hugely successful PK Program. Anyone interested in enrolling their child into our tuition based PK Program (4 years old by 12/31/2021) should call the Academy office to register. If the decision to offer SHCA a contract with the city is overturned, your child would be eligible for that program.

Congratulations to the Class of 2021! Last week they received their graduation rings. The symbol of this ring is a reminder of the Catholic values our students have learned, all of the knowledge they have acquired over the years, and the friendships they have developed that will hopefully last a very long time. This ring also represents the sacrifices that their parents have made so that they could reap the benefits of a Catholic education.

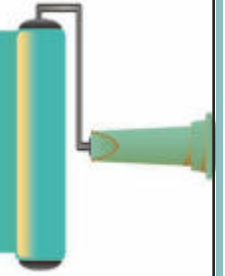
