On Friday, February 5th, Sacred Heart Parish will have a Holy Hour in honor of 1st Friday after the 8:30am Mass. There will be exposition of The Blessed Sacrament from 9:00 to 10:00am concluding with Benediction. All are invited to honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus every 1st Friday.

On Saturday, February 6th following 1st Friday, there will be exposition of The Blessed Sacrament from 7:00 -8:00am in honor of The Immaculate Heart of Mary.



HOLY WATER BLESSING The next Holy Water Blessing will take place next weekend February 6 & 7 at all the Masses.

Holy Water is regular water that has been blessed. It is a sacramental of the Church which means that it has been set aside for a sacred purpose. For us as Catholics, it's main purpose is to remind us of our Baptism. It represents the presence of the Most Holy Trinity within us. Since we have been made holy through holy water it sets us aside from the evils of the world. We use it also as a blessing of our homes, statues, rosaries and other objects that remind us of the presence of God among us.

During the pandemic, we have not been allowed to leave Holy Water in the fonts at the door or in the large font for people to take home. Each First Sunday of the month, we invite you to bring water in your own Holy Water bottles from home. They will be blessed at the end of each Mass. When you use it, please remember to pray for your family and friends and everyone else in our parish who will share in its blessings.



On December 8, 2020 Pope Francis proclaimed "The Year of St. Joseph" which will last until December 8, 2021. Whenever a Pope announces a special year of prayer it is the hope that each Catholic will renew their devotion to that particular saint or to a particular theological virtue, as we recently celebrated, "The Year of Mercy." In order to enter into "The Year of St. Joseph" as a parish community more fully, beginning this Sunday, January 31st, there will be the opportunity for 35 Parish Households to host the statue of the "Sleeping St. Joseph" for nine-day novena slots until December 8, 2021. (This new devotion made popular by Pope Francis, reveals Saint Joseph in a sleeping position because in the Scriptures, God always spoke to him in his dreams. Part of this devotion is to place intentions on a small strip of paper and place them under his pillow so that he may present them to the Lord while we are sleeping).

Each household will be given their own small statue of the Sleeping St. Joseph (so there is no passing around one statue from house to house), a reminder of the days that you will be hosting the Novena, a prayer to say each night together and the opportunity to place small strips of paper with special intentions written on it by members of the household to place under the Sleeping St. Joseph's pillow for the duration of the novena and beyond. Each household is asked to pick up from the rectory the statue and prayer card the day before your novena begins.

The response to participate in the Nine-Day Novena has been overwhelming. There are no more novena slots available.

May God bless you all through the intercession of St. Joseph, Foster Father of Jesus, Husband of Mary, and Patron of the Universal Church, this year and always!





Faith Grows in Our Classrooms

Faith is growing each day in classrooms throughout Sacred Heart Catholic Academy. Our school is centered through our love of Christ and the strength of our faith. We are blessed with teachers who guide our students on their path to fully knowing and loving Jesus and families who are committed to providing this opportunity for their children.

New Registrations

Anyone interested in enrolling their child into our tuition based PK Program (4 years old by 12/31/2021) should call the Academy office to register. If the decision to offer SHCA a contract with the city is overturned, your child would be eligible for that program.
