






The Rectory Office will be closed on Monday, February 15th in observance of Presidents' Day. The Church will be closed after the 8:30am Mass.

Wednesday, February 17th is Ash Wednesday.

Ashes will be distributed during the Masses at 8:30am and 7:30pm and the 3:30pm Prayer Service. Ashes will also be distributed, to those who are not



comfortable going into the Church, outside the front doors of the Church from 8:00-8:30am, from 3:00-3:30pm. and 7:00-7:30 pm.

All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. All faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.



Stations of the Cross will be prayed each Friday during Lent at 7:30 pm, beginning February 19th, in the Church. Please come and walk the way of suffering with Jesus and one another.

Preparing Global Leaders

Sacred Heart Catholic Academy of Glendale is constantly developing new ways to prepare our students for a rapidly changing world.
