The group will meet next **Sunday, March 7th @ 6:00 pm** in the Church Basement. Come make some friends and explore your faith.

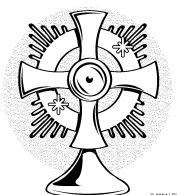

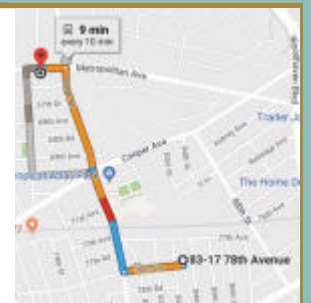
