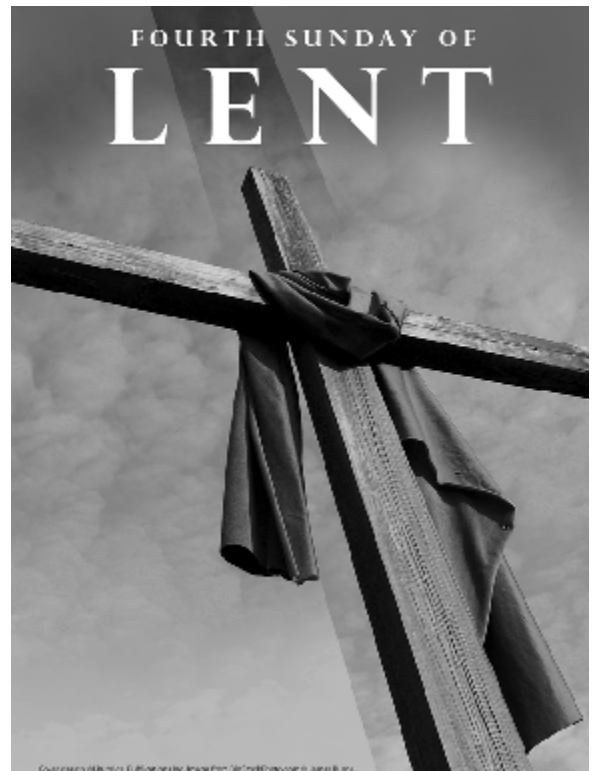


RCIA—THE SCRUTINIES

Continuing this Sunday and next Sunday, the Rite of Scrutinies will be celebrated at the 9:30am Sunday Masses in preparation for the Easter Vigil. The Scrutinies are a series of ancient blessings and gestures which take seriously the profound love of God and the desire of God to bring all people to full freedom and salvation. It is a time of final soul searching and strengthening of the Elect (those preparing for the Sacraments.) It is a time of reflection on one's life as we prepare to meet Christ in the Easter Sacraments. SCHOOL NEWS

"For we are his handiwork, created in Christ Jesus for the good works that God has prepared in advance," Eph 2:4-10

- This phrase calls to mind two practices that are alive within Catholic Academies and Parish Schools. First, we are created by God in His image. Second, we are created to live through good works and in the spirit of Jesus.
- Children in Catholic Academies are taught from a young age that God has designed each of us in a special way. Each of us is perfectly made in His image.
- Through this, we celebrate the differences that make us unique but also connect us all together in the likeness of God.
- Students are also prepared to live through good works by participating in projects and activities that are centered on helping others.

At Sacred Heart Catholic Academy our students are involved in many "in house" good works. We have a Buddy Program whereby older grades are paired with younger grades for seasonal activities including Religious opportunities in church. SHCA promotes academics with our Reading Buddies Program and Peer Tutoring. In the community, our students collect food for the Parish Pantry, clothing, toiletries, and toys for groups in need. As a school we raise money for Breast Cancer Awareness in October and Heart Healthy Month – Go Red in February. Our "good works" initiatives also include certificates for Student of the Month which highlights non-academic exemplary qualities and Peace Maker which acknowledges students who demonstrate peace filled and positive Christian behavior.

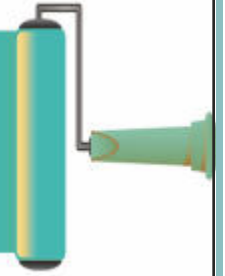

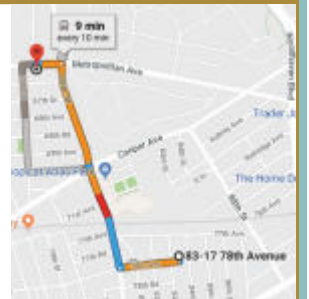
