

## SCHOOL NEWS

*“All, from least to greatest, shall know me, says the LORD, Jer 31:31-34*

- This verse highlights the importance of everyone having access to knowing Jesus.
- The love and knowledge of Christ should begin with the youngest among us. It is for all believers whether they are starting their faith journey as children or have welcomed Christ later in their lives.
- Even the youngest students begin their faith journey in Catholic Academies.

Sacred Heart Catholic Academy students engage with the sacraments throughout the normal school year. This week grades 3-8 will be brought over to church on Tuesday for Reconciliation during Lent.

Our academy has communal prayer each morning and we highlight special times in the church year with prayer services, re-enacting the Stations of the Cross and the First Christmas, reciting the Rosary, receiving Ashes on Ash Wednesday, and having the children's throats blessed on the Feast of Saint Blaise. We prepare our students for the sacraments of First Eucharist, First Reconciliation, and Confirmation.

This week our second trimester report cards will be released through Option C on Tuesday. Teacher phone conferences will take place on Thursday afternoon and evening by appointment. Our students will have an early dismissal on Thursday to allow for these conferences.

There will be a Confirmation Sponsors' Meeting on Thursday at 7:30 pm via Zoom.

Next weekend will be our Easter Plant and Palm Sale. Please help support our Academy with your purchase.

Last Tuesday we held an Oratorical Contest that was supposed to take place last year. Mr. Jack Seely has been meeting with the students through Zoom to practice and prepare for this event. Four students competed and did a fantastic job earning scores that were very close. ## HOLY WATER BLESSING

**The next Holy Water Blessing will take place only on Easter Sunday, April 4th at all the Masses.**

Holy Water is regular water that has been blessed. It is a sacramental of the Church which means that it has been set aside for a sacred purpose. For us as Catholics, it's main purpose is to remind us of our Baptism. It represents the presence of the Most Holy Trinity within us. Since we have been made holy through holy water it sets us aside from the evils of the world. We use it also as a blessing of our homes, statues, rosaries and other objects that remind us of the presence of God among us.

During the pandemic, we have not been allowed to leave Holy Water in the fonts at the door or in the large font for people to take home. Each First Sunday of the month, we invite you to bring water in your own Holy Water bottles from home. They will be blessed at the end of each Mass. When you use it, please remember to pray for your family and friends and everyone else in our parish who will share in its blessings.




