 \cdot Children who receive a Catholic education are more likely to be accepting of others and embrace differences. The concept of loving others as God loves us translates into accepting, empathetic adults.

At SHCA many grades learn about different cultures through Social Studies. In the Junior High grades, in addition to researching different cultures, the students participate in serious discussions based on current events. In the younger grades special activities are planned throughout the year celebrating differences. Teachers engage in "teachable moments" when there is negativity among students and they work toward a positive outcome of acceptance. Our Guidance Counselor works with our students on all grade levels to guide them in conflict resolution and to instill an acceptance of one another.

This week our students in grades 4, 6, and 7 will be taking the NYS ELA Tests. The tests have been modified this year to accommodate all the different learning models throughout the state. In addition our Book Fair will be held outdoors in the schoolyard on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. I hope the weather cooperates!

Next Saturday, the eighth graders will be receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. Please keep them in your prayers.
