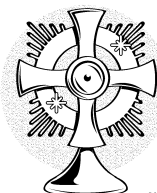

your faith.

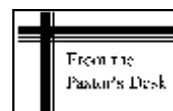

HOLY WATER BLESSING

**The next Holy Water Blessing will take place next
weekend, May 1st & 2nd at all the Masses.**

Holy Water is regular water that has been blessed.
It is a sacramental of the Church which means that it has
been set aside for a sacred purpose. For us as Catholics,
it's main purpose is to remind us of our Baptism. It rep-
resents the presence of the Most Holy Trinity within us.
Since we have been made holy through holy water it sets
us aside from the evils of the world. We use it also as a
blessing of our homes, statues, rosaries and other objects
that remind us of the presence of God among us.

During the pandemic, we have not been allowed to leave
Holy Water in the fonts at the door or in the large font for
people to take home. Each First Sunday of the month,
we invite you to bring water in your own Holy Water
bottles from home. They will be blessed at the end of
each Mass. When you use it, please remember to pray
for your family and friends and everyone else in our par-
ish who will share in its blessings.

The Annual Catholic Appeal helps each parish to be part

lyn helping to fund so many social, medical, and voca-

given back to Sacred Heart Parish to use for our own
needs.

SCHOOL NEWS

Beloved, we are God's children now; what we shall be has not yet been revealed. (1 John 3:1-2)

- The "Catholic School Difference" is a phrase that is often mentioned when discussing Catholic Education.
- Teachers and staff view each student as a child of God, whose God given potential lies within.
- Each student has the potential to grow in limitless fashion. The belief that all children are valued and important is paramount in Catholic education.
- As Catholic educators, the goal is to help a child discover their potential and see where God will lead them.

This week's reading offers the opportunity to connect to the programs that the school has available to teach all children as well as emphasize the inclusion of all children. In understanding that all children are blessed by God with the potential to grow and are part of God's plan, the school emphasizes helping all children discover their gifts.

Our teachers differentiate their lessons in order to address students' different learning styles and abilities. Some strategies that are used include small group instruction, group work, pair and share, one to one assistance, and digital apps. We also offer Peer Tutoring opportunities as well as After School Clubs that engage students such as Robotics, Chess, Drama, Reading Buddies, and Band. For Special Education students, SETSS, Occupational Therapy and Speech services are available. In addition, for those students who are struggling academically, we provide Title I services in Literacy and Math. Since last year we have an on-site Guidance Counselor that works with individual students, small groups of students, as well as entire classes as the need arises. Some of the topics she addresses are self-esteem issues and conflict resolution.

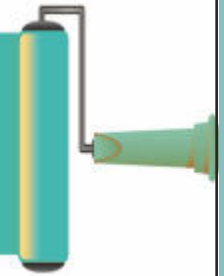

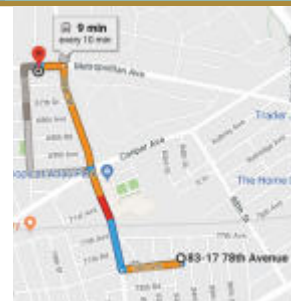
