

HOLY WATER BLESSING The next Holy Water Blessing will take place this weekend, May 1st & 2nd at all the Masses.

Holy Water is regular water that has been blessed. It is a sacramental of the Church which means that it has been set aside for a sacred purpose. For us as Catholics, it's main purpose is to remind us of our Baptism. It represents the presence of the Most Holy Trinity within us. Since we have been made holy through holy water it sets us aside from the evils of the world. We use it also as a blessing of our homes, statues, rosaries and other objects that remind us of the presence of God among us.

During the pandemic, we have not been allowed to leave Holy Water in the fonts at the door or in the large font for people to take home. Each First Sunday of the month, we invite you to bring water in your own Holy Water bottles from home. They will be blessed at the end of each Mass. When you use it, please remember to pray for your family and friends and everyone else in our parish who will share in its blessings.

The Ascension of the Lord is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics to attend Mass. Masses will be held on Wednesday, May 12th, (the eve of) at 7:30 p.m. and on Thursday, May 13th at 8:30 a.m.

The 2021 Annual Catholic Appeal has begun and is already underway! Our goal this year is \$63,870.

Unfortunately, we were \$7,000 short of last year's goal of \$63,410, and the balance had to come out of our savings to give to the diocese. Out of 668 registered households only 142 households contributed. Hopefully, this year more parishioners will prayerfully consider making a pledge so we can reach our goal! No donation is too small.

The Annual Catholic Appeal helps each parish to be part of the larger Church community of the Diocese of Brooklyn helping to fund so many social, medical, and vocational services. Any money that comes in over our goal is given back to Sacred Heart Parish to use for our own needs. God Bless you all and hope that you are healthy and peaceful.
