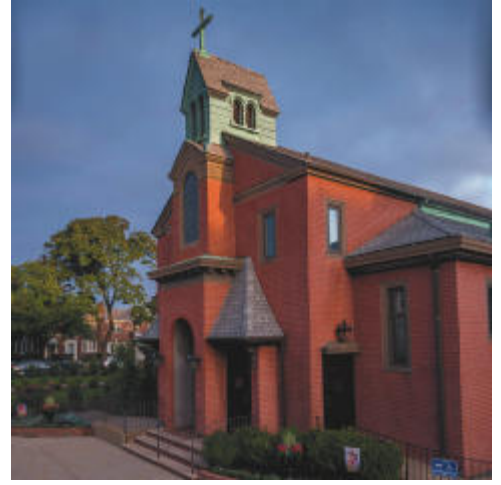

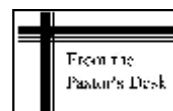
HOLY WATER BLESSING

The next Holy Water Blessing will take place this weekend, May 1st & 2nd at all the Masses.

Holy Water is regular water that has been blessed. It is a sacramental of the Church which means that it has been set aside for a sacred purpose. For us as Catholics, it's main purpose is to remind us of our Baptism. It represents the presence of the Most Holy Trinity within us. Since we have been made holy through holy water it sets us aside from the evils of the world. We use it also as a blessing of our homes, statues, rosaries and other objects that remind us of the presence of God among us.

During the pandemic, we have not been allowed to leave Holy Water in the fonts at the door or in the large font for people to take home. Each First Sunday of the month, we invite you to bring water in your own Holy Water bottles from home. They will be blessed at the end of each Mass. When you use it, please remember to pray for your family and friends and everyone else in our parish who will share in its blessings.

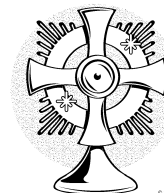

ASCENSION THURSDAY, MAY 13TH

The Ascension of the Lord is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics to attend Mass. Masses will be held on Wednesday, May 12th, (the eve of) at 7:30 p.m. and on Thursday, May 13th at 8:30 a.m.

The 2021 Annual Catholic Appeal has begun and is already underway! Our goal this year is \$63,870.

Many parishioners have already received the initial letter and pledge forms by mail from the Diocese and have made a contribution. Please know that the letters come from the Diocesan office with Fr. Fred's name on it as an official statement that the pledge has begun. We apologize if there have been duplicates sent requesting another pledge. Only ONE donation is necessary each year. Thank you for your incredible generosity to our parish and to this Annual Appeal!

Unfortunately, we were \$7,000 short of last year's goal of \$63,410, and the balance had to come out of our savings to give to the diocese. Out of 668 registered households only 142 households contributed. Hopefully, this year more parishioners will prayerfully consider making a pledge so we can reach our goal! No donation is too small.

The Annual Catholic Appeal helps each parish to be part of the larger Church community of the Diocese of Brooklyn helping to fund so many social, medical, and vocational services. Any money that comes in over our goal is given back to Sacred Heart Parish to use for our own needs. God Bless you all and hope that you are healthy and peaceful.

SCHOOL NEWS

Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth. (1 John 3:18-24)

- It's always interesting to see the mad rush following Mass to get out of the parking lot. Loving your neighbor goes right out the window when trying to get out of the spaces first.
- If we cannot live the Gospel and the words of Christ then speaking them is immaterial.
- Children must see examples of Christ like actions around them to fully understand what it means to follow Christ. This of course begins at home with families who are committed to living as Christ. A child's education is the next opportunities to experience role models of Christ.
- Children who attend a Catholic school are less likely to experience behavior problems or observe negative behaviors in their classrooms. Having positive peer and teacher role models makes a significant difference in a child's formative years

During the month of May, students will celebrate Mary as the Mother of Jesus and the Church. Mary is the ultimate example of living her faith in word, truth, and deed. During this month, in addition to classroom activities, the students recite a decade of the Rosary each week as a community. Our tradition has been for our students to engage in a May Crowning Para-liturgy hosted by our second graders who have recently received First Eucharist.

Each month we acknowledge students in each grade who demonstrate positive behaviors in our Academy and award them Student of the Month Certificates. We also recognize our students who exhibit Christ like actions each trimester and present them with the Peacemaker Award.

This week students in grades 4, 6, and 7 will take the NYS Math Tests. On Friday we will have our First Friday Prayer Service and award Student of the Month Certificates for April and wish a Happy Birthday to all our May Birthdays. Grade 2 received the sacrament of First Reconciliation yesterday. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare for First Eucharist at the end of the month.

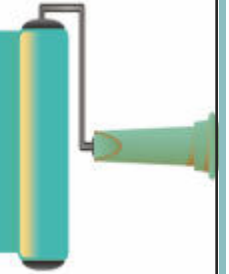

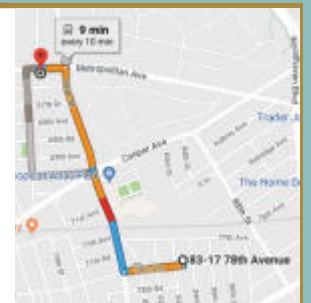
