

SCHOOL NEWS

Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (<u>Mt 28:16-20</u>)

- Today's passage highlights the significance of the celebration of the Trinity. In our Baptism, we are united through the healing waters to the Trinity.
- God is always with us through the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- The Trinity is one of the fundamental beliefs of Catholicism. While today is the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, consider how often we are reminded of the three entities (in the Creed, prayers throughout Mass, and of course, the sign of the cross).

Sacred Heart Catholic Academy helps our children understand the Trinity. Students engage in this important understanding through age appropriate St. Patrick's Day activities, learning about the Sign of the Cross and the Creed. In addition we are fortunate to be able to call upon the clergy of the parish to work with our students to provide support and instruction about this topic as well as many others.
