



Congratulations to the students of Sacred Heart Catholic Academy who graduated on Friday, June 11th. We wish them a wonderful summer vacation and much success as they embark on their new academic life in High School!

SCHOOL NEWS

We are ambassadors for Christ, as if God were appealing through us. (2 Cor 5:14-21)

- Today's reading reminds us of our role as ambassadors. When we are baptized in the faith, we are not simply asked to practice it in isolation.
- Faith is meant to be shared. The simplest route is to share the faith with likeminded individuals. To be true ambassadors however, we must carry the faith into the world and allow everyone to experience the knowledge and love of Christ.
- This will look different for each person. To be an ambassador of Christ can mean sharing His words or living through His actions. We are each called in different ways to bring Christ to the World. How are you answering the call to be an ambassador of Christ?
- Catholic education prepares students to carry the faith into adulthood (statistically more likely to be practicing Catholics, raise a family in the faith, volunteer, and become involved in the community).
- As we think about the graduating class, it is full of hope that we send the graduates to their next adventure having taught them to be ambassadors of Christ. We believe they will shine the light of Christ as they begin their next chapter.

This week will be a busy one as our youngest students celebrate Moving Up and Graduation ceremonies. Nursery 1 and 2 will each have their Moving Up Ceremony on Tuesday. Kindergarten Graduates on Wednesday and PreK for All 1, 2, and 3 will each celebrate Moving Up on Thursday.
