

# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is on Friday, June 11th. There will be a special Mass at 8:30 a.m. to celebrate our patronal feast day and remember all past & present Parishioners, Priests and Deacons, Sisters of St. Dominic, School Staff and Alumni of Sacred Heart Parish.

#### <u>THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF</u> <u>CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)</u>

Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish will celebrate the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ this Sunday, June 6th with a procession of the Holy Eucharist through the streets of Glendale following the 11:30am Mass. We will begin the drive-by procession from the front doors of the Church at approximately 12:30 p.m. So, listen for the altar bells as the procession enters your block!



"Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Mk 14:12-16, 22-26

• As Catholics, we have the unique opportunity to receive the Eucharist, consecrated as the body and blood of Christ. Each mass focuses our attention on the Eucharist and the presence of Christ.

• This feast remembers the meal shared on Holy Thursday, but the mood is much more joyful as we focus on the gift of the Eucharist versus the coming death of Jesus.

• We are also reminded, through the Eucharist, that we are "one Body" in the Church of Christ. We are unified in the Communion of Christ to other believers as well as to Christ Himself.

• Our participation in this sacrament invites the Trinity to live within us. It also serves as a reminder of Jesus' redemptive actions to save us from sin and how we must participate in it. The Eucharist is at the center of our Mass and the idea of "communion" conveys our connection to each other in our faith as well as a connection to Jesus. While many families attend Mass and receive the Eucharist, students within Catholic Academies are fortunate to partake in the Eucharist as a school community. This experience with the Eucharist is incredibly important as it strengthens student's connection with Christ and with each other.

Our students in grades 1-8 attend mass weekly as a school community in conjunction with the Parish community. Each month a particular grade is responsible for hosting a First Friday Mass. In addition each grade, including Nursery, PK, and Kindergarten attends a Sunday mass as well. These masses allow our students to experience and take part in the wonderful celebration that is the mass. Through their teachers, the priests and deacon, the children are learning firsthand about the Eucharist. This year, the pandemic has made it difficult to attend mass as a school, but we look forward to the lifting of restrictions and continuing our attendance at weekly mass in the fall. In the meantime, our students have had weekly virtual prayer services officiated by Deacon Stamm. We've prayed the Rosary, held a May Crowning, and participated in Penance as well as continued to prepare for and provide First Eucharist for our second graders and Confirmation for our eighth graders.

This week begins with our fourth and eighth graders taking the NYS Science Written Exam on Monday. Due to the pandemic, the lab portion of the exam is being omitted this year. We end the week on a high note, our eighth graders will have their Graduation in person on Friday evening. We congratulate them for all of their hard work under difficult circumstances. They certainly made the best of an unusual school year and remained focused through it all. We wish them all the best as they take the next step in their educational journey.

- Please include the DATE & TIME, FOR WHOM THE MASS IS INTENDED, WHO IS REQUESTING THE MASS along with a phone number and email address for questions and/or confirmation and receipt.
- Include your 1<sup>st</sup> choice and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice should your 1<sup>st</sup> choice not be available.
- The cost of Masses remains at \$15.00 each.

September 11th, All Souls Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day AND on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of each month at 8:30am(Purgatorial Society Members Mass).
