

## 15th Year Old Patron Saint of the Internet

"Carlo Acutis (May 3, 1991-October 12, 2006) was an Italian 15 year old Catholic young man and an amateur computer programmer who was best known for documenting Eucharistic Miracles around the world and cataloging them onto a Website he created before his death from Leukemia (miracolieucaristici.org).

He was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Mass and the Eucharist which became a core theme of his life. He was given the title "Blessed" (beatified) on October 10, 2020. The approved miracle for his beatification was the curing of a young Brazilian boy of a rare pancreatic disease."

Sacred Heart Parish will honor Blessed Carlo at the 8:30 a.m. Mass with the veneration of his picture that has been placed in the Statue area. Those who are given the title "Blessed" are very powerful intercessors before the Most Holy Trinity. One more miracle is needed for approval for the "Blessed" to be canonized a Saint. All parishioners are invited to the Mass and to bring a special intention, one that needs a miraculous intervention, so that it may be placed before the image of Blessed Carlo and offered up in prayer through his intercession on that day.
