



FAITH FORMATION CORNER....

Next Sunday, November 7th, our 7th Grade/Level Academy, Faith Formation, and RCIA Teen Year 1 students will officially begin their two years of confirmation preparations. The Confirmation Investiture at the 9:30 Mass is their first step in preparing for Confirmation in the spring of 2023. This third Sacrament of Initiation confirms and strengthens the baptismal grace begun at Baptism. The Investiture is a pledge made by candidates to fully participate in the preparations leading up to the celebration of Confirmation with the guidance of their parents and sponsor. This commitment includes faithfully participating in Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation Masses, completing all required classwork and assignments, researching and writing about a Saint whose name they will take at Confirmation, and placing their talents at the service of others through 20 hours of community service. They also commit to showing concern for those around them in their families and community and to open their mind and heart to the activity of the Holy Spirit.

We, the parish community in turn commit to offering the Confirmation Candidates support and prayers throughout the process and beyond. I ask that you keep them and all our students in your prayers.
